

Special Rules of the Day

RULE 1.

Except in the case of physical challenge, delegates wishing to speak shall rise and await recognition by the Presiding Officer. Once recognized, and if the Delegate's purpose for seeking recognition is in order, the Delegate shall clearly state their Name and County before presenting their motion or inquiry.

RULE 2.

No Delegate shall speak in debate more than once on the same question and for no longer than one (1) minutes. The right to speak more than once can only be granted by a majority vote of the District Convention.

RULE 3.

The period of debate for each question shall not exceed twenty (10) minutes but delegates have the right to extend debate in five (5) minute increments by majority vote (1/2) of the convention attendees.

RULE 4.

Resolutions from the floor not submitted through one of the county parties may only be considered after all other business of the convention has been completed. Resolutions from the floor require a 2/3-majority vote of the body for consideration and debate. All such resolutions must be submitted to the Presiding Officer in legible writing or in electronic format for consideration.
